WHAT IS PERIOD POVERTY?

Period poverty is the inadequate access to menstrual products, education, and resources due to social, cultural, and political factors

500 MILLION people are affected by period poverty globally

1 IN 4 students in the US have struggled with period poverty





CAUSES OF PERIOD POVERTY

- TAX on period products
- Societal menstrual STIGMA
- Lack of reproductive health EDUCATION
